'Ehphatha': Be opened. Mark, 7:34

Today's Gospel invites our openness of mind and heart.

Open, to the maker of heaven and earth...

Open, to the power of the word, speaking to 'all faint hearts...' courage, do not be afraid"

Open, to the one who makes all things new.

Open, to the breath (Ruah), that breathes through the world...giving it life at every moment.

Open, to a reality the deficiencies of our gendered language.

Open, to a horizon which can never be confined by our generational narcissism.

Open, to the delicacy of the mussle and the majesty of the mountain, both fragile and dependant on God.

Open, to recovering a sense of spirit - with the awareness that 'we live and move and share our being with God'

Open, to hearing God's word and proclaiming his faith, praise and glory (Rite of Baptism—Ephphatha) by the witness of our lives.

Open, to celebrate that we are the spitting image of God. ('...he touched his tongue with spittle' Mark 7:33)

Open, to 'looking up to heaven ad sighing', in prayer, hope, faith, frustration and trust.
